- Trash cans out too soon or not put away in a timely manner; & not storing them out of view.
- Trailers or boats parked on your lot or driveway.
- Not maintaining your lawn and landscaping.
- Making updates or changes without first submitting an application to the ARB.

Please also note: the City of DeBary may require a permit for certain types of work. If you're unsure whether a permit is needed, you can contact the City at 386-601-0212. Failing to obtain a necessary permit may result in fines or delays—so it's always best to check first.
